¹⁸ And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. ¹⁹ Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." ²⁰ They immediately left their nets and followed Him. ²¹ Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets. He called them, ²² and immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him.

As Christians then, each of us are called to follow Christ and become 'fishers of men'



so that others may come to Christ and know the gift of salvation.

How's The Fishing?

Have you been casting your net to bring more people to the Lord? Or have you been hesitant because the enemy has

reminded you that you tried before and failed? Let me encourage you using Peter as an example again (Luke 5:4-7). ⁴ When he finished speaking, he turned to Simon. He said, "Go out into deep water. Let the nets down so you can catch some fish." ⁵ Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." ⁶ When they had done so, they caught a large number of fish. There were so many that their nets began to break. ⁷ So they motioned to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. They came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.

Peter tried before and failed as well; but because Christ said so... *Let down the nets.*
